

# HONEYBUSH TEA

*Variety for different tastes*



Honeybush tea, made from *Cyclopia* species, has a complex flavour with floral, fruity, and woody notes, a slightly sweet taste, and a mild astringent mouthfeel that lends body.

## *C. intermedia*

Predominantly floral with a rose perfume (rose petals) note and a hint of cinnamon (sweet spice).

A sweet, fruity and floral character with notes of caramel, apricot and apple crumble (cooked apple combined with cinnamon).

A full-bodied tea with apricot and rose geranium notes and a hint of bitter.

Similar aroma character to *C. genistoides*.
