
HONEYBUSH TEA

Variety for different tastes



Apricot

Honeybush tea, made from *Cyclopia* species, has a complex flavour with floral, fruity, and woody notes, a slightly sweet taste, and a mild astringent mouthfeel that lends body.

Predominantly floral with a rose perfume (rose petals) note and a hint of cinnamon (sweet spice).






Apple crumble

A sweet, fruity and floral character with notes of caramel, apricot and apple crumble (cooked apple combined with cinnamon).
